Just In: Results for the Delegate Texting Poll at the State Convention

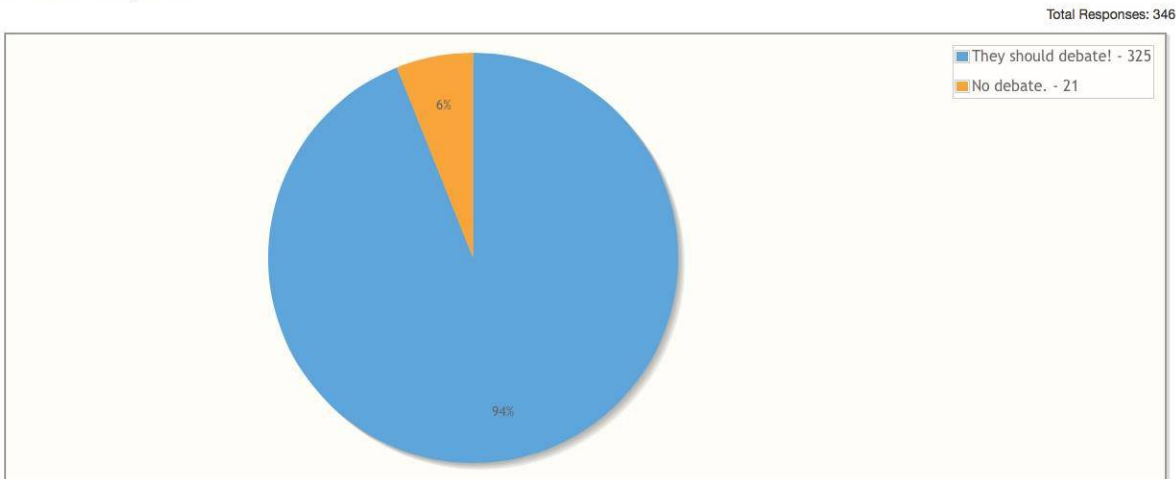
94% of Respondents Would Like Johnson and Herbert to Debate

Today at the Utah Republican Party State Organizing Convention, Utah businessman Jonathan Johnson officially announced his 2016 Republican run for Governor of Utah.

During Johnson's speech he called for a series of debates to be held "often and throughout our state" beginning in October to help voters evaluate the candidates. Mentioned topics for debate were: improving education, preserving states' rights, becoming fiscally self-reliant, and preparing for Utah's continued growth. Johnson asked convention attendees to text a number voicing their support or opposition to the debates.

Thus far, 346 convention attendees texted in their opinions. Of the 346 respondents, 325 respondents said they wanted the candidates to debate and 21 respondents replied they did not want the candidates to debate. (See the image below).
