Jonathan Johnson, Chairman of the Board at <u>Overstock.com</u>, Announces 2016 Run for Governor

Today at the Utah Republican Party State Organizing Convention, Utah businessman Jonathan Johnson officially announced his 2016 run for Governor of Utah.

Johnson is the current chairman of the board and the former president and acting CEO of the Utah-grown company <u>Overstock.com</u>.

Throughout Johnson's 13 years with Overstock, his leadership has helped grow the business from approximately 50 employees and \$50 million in annual sales to over 1,800 Utah employees and \$1.5 billion in annual sales.

"I ask that you spend the next many months getting to know me. Put me through a rigorous interview process. I am confident you will see that my candidacy represents the difference between having someone who leads and someone who merely manages," Johnson said.

Johnson's closing statement included an assurance: "I am ready to lead Utah. Hire me as your next governor. [I am the] leader who has a bigger vision of a brighter future for the State of Utah."
